The Commission will review, possibly rank, and then grant funds to the projects they would like to see implemented.
- **B.** The Commission may authorize funding be released in specific amounts, to particular Conservation Districts, for applications they choose to fund.
- **C.** The Commission will consider authorizing Tim Rubald, serving as their Secretary, to negotiate with each funded Conservation District any funding issues, project monitor reporting, and any changes the Commission stipulates in a specific Funding Agreement, and to sign the agreement with successful Districts on the Commission's behalf.
