Fall sale of native and desert adapted plants Saturday, October 22

LAS VEGAS, Nev. – The Nevada Division of Forestry State Tree Nursery in Las Vegas will host a fall plant sale on Saturday, October 22 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. There are currently more than 60 species of native and desert-adapted trees and shrubs, as well as feature species appropriate for Mount Charleston and similar higher elevation environments. Native plants are water efficient, can help prevent soil erosion and provide habitat for native wildlife.

Plants are available in one to 15 gallon containers and prices range from \$5 to \$15. A listing of current inventory is available at <http://forestry.nv.gov/ndf-state-forest-nurseries/las-vegas-state-tree-nursery/>.

The nursery program is not intended to provide landscaping materials for small home lots. Plants purchased are to be used for conservation purposes, such as water conservation, windbreaks, soil erosion control and wildlife habitat enhancement.

The nursery, open year round, is located at 9600 Tule Springs Road, inside Floyd Lamb Park and accepts cash and checks only.
