Technical Advisory Committee: Evaluation and ranking of grant applications; recommendation of award of grant; provision of information to Administrator. When evaluating completed grant applications for each periodic solicitation of grant applications, the Technical Advisory Committee shall:

- 1. Consider, without limitation:
- (a) The eligibility requirements for a grant;
- (b) The requirements and priorities for program
- (c) Any limitations set forth by the Administrator
- (d) The feasibility of the project; and
- (e) The estimated costs of the program and benefits to the pupils in this State.
- 2. Rank each application received in order of priority for awarding grants.
- 3. Recommend the amount of a grant to be awarded, if any, for a project proposed in a grant application.

4. Provide the Administrator with a ranked list of applicants and the recommended amount of the grant for each applicant.
