





WHAT IS THE NEVADA OUTDOOR EDUCATION AND RECREATION GRANT PROGRAM?



Purpose

To provide high-quality outdoor education and recreation opportunities for Nevada students.



Goals

- Provide Nevada students with high-quality opportunities to directly experience the natural world.
- Expose young minds to the environment, agriculture, and natural resources to promote environmental literacy.
- Seek to improve academic performance, self-esteem, personal responsibility, community involvement, personal health, and understanding of nature for all Nevada children.



Who can apply?

Eligible applicants include: public agencies; public, private, and charter schools; non-profit organizations; tribal governments; and community-based entities.



What projects are eligible?

Eligible programs and covered costs directly support outdoor recreation and education activities for students 18 years or younger, prioritizing children who face barriers to outdoor access. Tier I microgrants are available for projects up to \$7,500. Tier II grants are available for projects up to \$50,000.



Is there a match requirement?

A match is not required, but is encouraged to strengthen applications.
